Steps To Follow

- 1. Send completed Application to the Breed Recorder in your State/Territory with a copy of the ANKC Registered Pedigree, a stamped addressed business size envelope and \$10.00 cheque or money order. Your Rottweiler must be microchipped and a copy of the Microchip Certificate is to be sent with the Application.
- 2. Arrange an appointment with your Vet to have your dog x-rayed. Take along the paperwork. Make sure the Vet assesses the bite while the dog is awake. Counting teeth can best be done while the dog is under anaesthetic. The Hip & Elbow X-rays must be taken under General Anaesthetic. The x-ray plates and all the appropriate forms must be identified with the microchip number, NRCA paperwork number and the dog's ANKC registration number. Make certain that the Vet has completed all parts of the forms he/she is required to.
- 3. Send x-rays and completed paperwork to Reader of your choice from the list provided together with payment of fees. Return the Blue copy Dental and Eye Certificates to the National Breed Recorder as per the forms.
- 4. Results from the Reader are sent to your Vet and a copy to the National Breed Recorder. The State Breed Recorder will eventually get copies and retain the copies.
- 5. The result is then listed in the National Hip/Elbow Dysplasia Register.

NOTE: The Hip x-ray and Dental and Eye examination can be done by any Veterinarian. It is possible to get a Specialist Eye Examination, although not compulsory.
